### **Phylum Chordata From Sea Otters to Sea Squirts**

Phylum Chordata From Sea Otters to Sea Squirts • The Big Four! - pharyngeal slits - a series of openings that connect the inside of the throat to the outside of the "neck" These are often, but not always, used as gills - dorsal nerve cord - a bundle of nerve fibers which runs down the "back"

Salton Sea History The Salton Sea was formed in 1905 when Colorado River flood flows breached an irrigation diversion structure and temporarily flowed into the then-dry Salton Sink The present sea is only the latest in a succession of waterbodies occupying the Salton Sink

### **3. The Sea Urchin**

Sea urchin and sand dollar gametes can be obtained in large numbers by intracoelomic injection of 0.5M KCl or by electrical stimulation; this leads to the shedding of gametes into sea water (in the case of eggs) or 'dry' into a dish (in the case of sperm) Depending on the species, several millilitres of

### **Big Sagebrush: A Sea Fragmented into Lakes, Ponds, and ...**
